Dear Parents/Caregivers

The Cunderdin District High School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contribution and Charges for 2025. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$40 per student in Kindergarten, \$60 per student in Pre-primary - Year 6 and \$235 per student in Year 7 – 10 which is in line with the School Education Regulation 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. It is therefore vital for the school to receive your family's contribution to allow us to purchase resources to assist in your child's education.

The School Board has suggested a number of options to be offered to assist parents making their contribution.

OPTION 1

Primary K - 6	A single contribution of \$40 per Kindy or \$60 per Pre-primary - Year 6 (this may be paid at the School Office or direct to School account).
Secondary 7 - 10	A single contribution of \$235.00

OPTION 2

Kindergarten	\$10 per Term
PP - Year 6	Four equal contributions - \$15 per Term
Secondary 7 - 10	A single contribution of \$235.00

OPTION 3

Kindergarten	Two payments - each of \$20 made in the first week of each semester.
PP - Year 6	Two payments - each of \$30 made in the first week of each semester.
Secondary 7 - 10	Two payments - each of \$117.50 made in the first week of each semester.

Direct Payment to school account may be made in 2025.

The School Board would like to point out the contribution per child equates to \$1.50 per Primary student and \$5.87 approx. per Secondary student per week over the course of the year.

We also point out that all contributions are used for the direct benefit of the children. Our aim is to raise our community's contribution rate to 100% for the benefit of all our children.

2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions and activities for 2025 have been included in the table attached. Details collected in previous years has helped guide the 2025 estimate of charges. The amounts shown represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities for 2025.

3. Items for Personal Use

The list of items for personal use will vary from class to class and includes:

- Stationery items for student use
- Recommended requirements for student use e.g. tissues, art shirt
- Requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. Year 10 Leavers' Shirt

The recommended list of items for personal use for your child is attached. Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it will be necessary to replace some items, such as pens and pencils, throughout the year.

4. Other Voluntary Approved requests

- The Cunderdin District High School P & C Association voluntary approved request will be \$10.00 per child.
- The Voluntary Library Contribution is \$10.00 per child and will be used for the upgrading of Library Resources.
- The Voluntary Chaplaincy Fund Contribution of \$10.00 per child will be used to support the School's Chaplain.
