<b>1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS</b>

A contribution is 'voluntary' and the funds are used towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by students in the educational program. A maximum of \$235.00 contribution and charges for Secondary may be asked.	
<b>2. ADDITIONAL APPROVED VOLUNTARY FUNDING REQUESTS</b>	
Library Contribution	This amount will contribute towards the purchase of Library Resource Materials for all students.
P&C Contribution	This amount will contribute to the work of the Parents and Citizens Association in support of enhancing the learning environment for all students.
Chaplaincy Contribution	To assist with the implementation of the Chaplaincy Program at the school.
<b>3. CHARGES - Extra Cost Options</b>
